

## Tri-Valley Challenge – 2018

Shows include the Greenville and Yarra Yarra 2018 Shows, January 1, 2018 to November 1, 2018.



**Show Highpoint Awards**, sponsored by Rise Above Equestrian, Elena Flaharty & Friends:

- Each show will have two highpoint awards. Training to Fourth, and FEI Levels.
- If weekend has 2 show licenses, then each day will have highpoint winners.
- Winners receive special highpoint ribbons (18" streamers and big rosettes) and a \$10 certificate.

### Series Highpoint Awards:

- **Devoted Competitor Award;** Awarded to an Adult Amateur Competitor.
  - Minimum requirement: competitor must show in three (3) competition dates, at least one (1) at Yarra Yarra and one (1) at Greenville.
  - At completion of minimum requirement, competitor will get one (1) entry to drawing.
  - Any additional competitions over minimum requirement will earn an additional entry to drawing.
  - Entries are by RIDER, and may enter competitions on multiple horses to earn more entries to drawing.
  - Winner will be drawn at the October 27, 2018 show.
  - Award; Tri-Valley Challenge saddle pad and Cooler.
- **Dedicated Coach Award;** Awarded to a Professional.
  - Minimum requirement: coach must bring clients, be present at the show, and be listed as "Coach" for at least two (2) competitors at three (3) competition dates. Must include one (1) day at Yarra Yarra and one (1) day at Greenville. (Coach not required to ride in the competition.)
  - Upon completion of minimum requirement, coach will get one (1) entry to drawing.
  - Additional entries to drawing given for **each client** brought to a Greenville or Yarra Yarra show where they are listed as Coach and present at the competition.
  - Award; Trip for two (2) to be determined by Tri-Valley sponsors, Tri-Valley Saddle pad and Cooler.
  - Winner will be drawn at the October 27, 2018 show.
- **West Coast Bred Award;** Awarded to Owner with horse bred in California, Oregon or Washington. Sponsored by "Northern California Dressage Community", Sue Thompson.
  - Eligible horses must be 4-7.
  - Horse must compete in a minimum of three (3) competition dates. Must include one (1) day at Yarra Yarra and one (1) day at Greenville.
  - Horse may be ridden by owner or trainer.
  - Scores earned at Training to Fourth Level will count towards the high score. Highest percent score earned by the horse will determine the winner.
  - Owner must declare horse to participate and provide breeder information. (Declaration form available online.)
  - Award; \$500 cash prize, Neck Ribbon, Tri-Valley Embroidered Cooler.
  - Winner will be announced at the October 27, 2018 show. (Scores from 10/28/2018 will not count toward high score.)
